Find a Noisy Miner bird and draw it in your journal 10 points	Make a stained glass window using sheets of contact with lots of beautiful flowers pressed in between the layers. Take a photo. 10 points	Bake a mudpie or a grass soup! Be sure to ask permission first and wear old clothes. 10 points	Vehicle data. Sit with an adult where you can see the road. Which colour vehicle is seen most? Make a tally. Add to journal. 10 points	Rainy day? Don't let that stop you! Ask to put on rain clothes and shoes and dance in the rain! Feels good! 10 points.	Grab a snack and sit in a sunny place to write a letter to someone you can't visit at the moment. Don't forget to post! 10 points	Leaf prints. Paint one side of a variety of leaves. 'Print' them on a journal page. Look at those veins! 10 points	Design a bee drinking station. Using a bowl, place a stone in the middle so bees can stand and drink. 10 points	Be quiet. Sit in a sunny position, cross your legs, sit up straight, close your eyes and concentrate on nature's sounds for 5 mins. 10 points
Sketch an area of your backyard. Try to notice where shadows and sunlight hit the objects you draw. 10 points	Choose a place in your yard. Write directions for another person to find it –include number of steps, left, right 10 points	Choose as many different leaves as you can. Look at the way veins take water to the ends of the leaf. Are the all the same? Draw some that show differences. 10 points	Write your spelling words on chalk on a path. Practise! 10 points	Water the garden each afternoon. Find out what times you are allowed to water if there are water restrictions in your area. 10 points	Find leaves that look chewed. Collect them and make an artwork with your chewing 'creature' in the middle. Be inventive – it could be ANYTHING chewing! 10 points	Look for patterns in nature. Find a pine cone and attempt to draw it, paying close attention to the patterns you see. 10 points	Look at a tree. It starts with a stem then branches into two. Then those branches double. Draw your own tree and see how many 'branchings' you can make on one page. 10 points	Make a map of your house using found objects outside. Take a photo of this for your journal. 10 points	Rock animals. Choose rocks from the yard that remind you of an animal. Use found objects, paint and your imagination to make these animals. 10 points
Create an obstacle course outside. Time how fast you: #hop it #skip it #run it. 10 points	The unknown bird See that bird? I don't know what kind it is. Draw it and colour it. 10 points	Find 'clods' of soil around the yard. Using clear glasses or plastic cups, see how long it takes for your clod to dissolve. Do all soils dissolve the same way? Record your results. 10 points	Be a geologist. Collect rocks. Sort them into categories – smooth, rough, round, flat, sharp, oval, square etc. Take photos. 10 points	Bird Watch! Find a crow or a raven and draw it in your journal. 10 points	Leaf bookmarks – choose long leaves. Paint designs on them, wait til dry and laminate! Great gifts. 10 points	Draw and colour creatures to camouflage in your garden. Match pencil colour with the colour of plants, flowers, etc. Cut out and see if your family can find them 10 points	Find a lady beetle. Draw it, paying close attention to the number and pattern of the dots. 10 points	Stand on a sunlit path and trace your feet with chalk. Have someone trace your shadow. Stand in the same place in an hour. Trace your shadow every hour. 10 points	Make your own gift wrapping by stamping leaves and flowers all over paper. 10 points
Lie on a path or trampoline and look at the clouds. Use your imagination. What do they look like? Draw what your imagination sees. 10 points	Rock habitats. Carefully look under rocks. Anything living there? Make a tally of minibeasts you find. 10 points	Are the leaves all falling off the trees in your yard? Rake them into piles. Ask an adult what to do with them. 10 points	Using string or wool and sticks, can you make a raft that floats? 10 points	Make a real stick man! Not a drawn one ⁽²⁾ Use twigs and found objects to make your character. Take a photo. 10 points	Pressing flowers is an old fashioned craft. Have an adult help you select your flowers and press them in between large heavy books. 10 points	Make butterflies from leaves and textas. Glue them into your journal. 10 points	Collect four interesting sticks to make a frame for your beautiful nature drawing. 10 points	Look for ant holes. What do you imagine it looks like underground? Draw an ant resort, where all the ants have a great time. What rooms do include? 10 points	Collect loads of leaves. Stick them with craft glue onto the bottom of a blown up balloon. When dry, pop the balloon. You have now created a leaf bowl! 10 points
Take a plastic bag and tie it over a leaf covered branch. Record what happens each hour. 10 points	Bird Watch! Find a Peewee (or Magpie Lark) and draw it. 10 points	Make a wall hanging from found objects in nature. 10 points	Make a flower or leaf crown. Pose for photos. Add to your journal. 10 points	Choose the best stick to make a magic wand. Create some spells using poetry and write these in your journal. 10 points	Take two sticks and tie them into a cross shape. Weave wool around each to make a 'God's Eye' ornament. 10 points	Birds – where? You can hear them, but not see them? Ask an adult to help record bird sounds. Identify them by sound when you see them! 10 points	Can you plait? Find long strappy leaves from plants in your garden. Staple three together and plait. 10 points	Wait until dark, then look at the night sky. Where is the moon? What shape is it tonight? Draw it every night over the week. 10 points	Make a wind chime. Use a stick and tie lengths of string that hold old spoons. Hang in a tree and listen to the wind blowing them. Ahhhh 10 points
